Rating Sheets:

YOU must fill in the following (starred*) information on your Edina rating sheet:

- <u>* Name of soloist or participants names in ensemble</u> (be SURE to fill this in—it is the only way we can be sure to get your correct score.)
- <u>* Time</u>: your scheduled time to perform
- <u>* Site:</u> room number
- <u>* Event number:</u> refer to attached schedule
- <u>* Event name</u>: flute solo, alto sax ensemble, etc.
- <u>* Selections, Composer, Publisher</u>
- NOTE: There is one rating sheet for <u>percussionist solo and ensembles</u> and a different one for <u>large</u> <u>group</u>, <u>small ensembles</u>, <u>and solos for brass/winds</u> make sure you have the correct one.
- There is a limited supply of extra rating sheets at the Edina Contest Headquarters.
- Final ratings will be posted outside headquarters, located just outside the music wing.

Give to the Judge:

1. rating sheet

2. original part for the judge of the performance selection (with the measures numbered).

Original Music: All music used by soloists, ensemble members, accompanists and the judges music **MUST BE ORIGINALS – NO PHOTOCOPIES** are permitted. (Exception: If you have a letter from the publisher or music store attached to the judge's copy stating that the music is either permanently out of print or on back order.)

Tuning: Remember to tune carefully to the piano. Pianos sometimes are flat but they rarely will be sharp. Tune carefully!

Dress: Dress up for this event! Look sharp – don't play sharp! ☺☺

Warm-up Room (Cafeteria): When you arrive you may get your instrument out of your band locker but go directly to the cafeteria to warm-up. There will be other groups performing in the band room so **DO NOT PLAY** in the band locker room. Security is not guaranteed in the cafeteria, so DO NOT bring purses or valuables. Students may practice in the cafeteria or if there is space, in the small Wenger practice modules but not in the halls.

Snacks: Snacks in vending machines are located in the cafeteria.
