## **CAMP WEEK**

Marching Band Camp: Marching Band Camp is required of ALL band students. It will be held at **Edina High School** from **9 a.m. to 4 p.m.**, August 17, 18, 20 and 21; **9 a.m. to 3 p.m.** August 19 (for Get Connected Day); and a mini-camp on August 28 from **3 p.m. to 5 p.m.**. Please refer to the enclosed calendar for details.

NOTE: 1) The morning of the first day (9 a.m.-12 p.m.) is for New High School Students and Leaders ONLY.

- 2) Arrive to Fick Auditorium ten minutes early every day (and as a general rule for all band events)
- 3) Students will need to bring a lunch every day.
- 4) Each day will have a theme, so you can dress up accordingly. Check the calendar for more details.

**Leadership Camp:** Leadership Camp is required of ALL students in leadership positions (i.e. Drum Majors, Section Leaders, and Band Crew). It will be held in the **EHS band room** from **1 p.m. to 5 p.m.**, **Thursday, August 13**. Bring a pencil, notepad (or a device to keep notes in), and athletic shoes. If you have any conflicts with leadership camp, let Mr. Richter know ASAP at andrew.richter@edinaschools.org.

**Drumline Camp:** Drumline Camp is required of ALL percussionists grades 10 - 12 (non percussion cymbal players included). It will be held in the **EHS band room and Fick Auditorium** from **9 a.m. to Noon, August 12, 13, and 14.** If you have any conflicts with drumline camp, let Mr. Richter know ASAP at andrew.richter@edinaschools.org.

**During Camp:** Many of you have learned that Marching Band is as much a physical activity as it is a musical one. Here is a quick list of things to give you the best possible experience during camp week...

- Get plenty of rest each night of camp
- Make sensible dietary choices during the week
- Dress for the weather each day (some mornings can be cool, be prepared)
- Have sunscreen, insect repellent, hat, sunglasses and a water bottle at every rehearsal (if you carry a water bottle on you at all times, you will never be thirsty or have to wait for the next planned water break)
- Bring your instrument, music, reeds, oil, sticks and everything else necessary to perform
- Wear athletic shoes and socks during all rehearsals (no flip flops, crocs, sandals, etc.)

# UNIFORM FITTINGS (Note: Uniform fittings will be at the Edina Community Center below the main gym)

## CONFLICTS WITH THE REHEARSAL/PERFORMANCE SCHEDULE

We go to great lengths to make it possible for you to be in band and ANY other activity you want to be involved in by working with you through the conflicts. If you are involved in a <u>fall sport/activity</u>, let Mr. Richter know ASAP via e-mail:

- 1) What sport/activity you're in
- 2) What level you are (10, JV, Varsity)
- 3) <u>Any</u> anticipated conflicts you may have with marching band camp or the marching band season. If and when you need to make a decision about what part of camp you will go to, **consult the calendar and try to be at as much pre-game and half-time rehearsing as possible**.

Both the band directors and coaches work hard to encourage students to participate in a variety of activities *without penalization*. We understand that you will miss some marching band rehearsals and some sports practices. Please understand, however, that you are still making a commitment to both groups.

Consult the enclosed calendar and **put the rehearsal and performance dates on your calendar today.** If you can reschedule any **pre-existing nonathletic** conflicts, it would be beneficial to your child and the whole band, however, we understand if it is not possible. Please avoid scheduling appointments or family events during rehearsals or performances if possible. Students with jobs must communicate to their employers that they are not available to work during an evening rehearsal or performance as work is not an acceptable reason to be absent. It is the student's responsibility to communicate all conflicts to all parties involved in a timely manner.

#### **ELIGIBILITY FORMS**

All band students are required to complete and return the Minnesota State High School League eligibility form in order to participate in the Edina band program. It is exciting to perform when there are hundreds of people at arms length watching the parade. We will have a rehearsal at ECC at 11:00 a.m. and leave around noon on **Saturday, August 29th**. Students should **eat lunch before** rehearsal and will need to bring money for food and activities at the fair. The parade starts at 2:00 pm. We start and end at the Haunted House.
