## CAMP WEEK

Marching Band Camp: Marching Band Camp is required of ALL 10-12 grade band students. It will be at Edina High School from August 20-24 (see calendar for times and details)

NOTE: 1) The morning of the first day ( 9 a.m.-12 p.m.) is for All 10th Grade Students, any new 11th and 12 th grade students, and<br>Leaders ONLY. Returning members are to report at $12: 30 \mathrm{pm}$ in Fick Auditorium..<br>2) Arrive to Fick Auditorium at EHS by $8: 50$ a.m. to check in and find your section.<br>3) Students will need to bring a lunch every day.<br>4) Each day will have a theme, so you can dress up accordingly. Check the calendar for more details.<br>5) Be a part of the 4-H club: Hydration, Hat, Healthy Foods, Happy Skin (i.e. sun screen, insect repellant, be prepared for all weather types)<br>6) We use Remind 101 to communicate to bandies throughout the year.
